


## POLITICAL SCIENCE DATABASE: OVERVIEW














# NEW E-BOOKS: E-BOOK CENTRAL

Titled (On the Physiology of Voice Production in South-Siberian **Throat** Singing: **Analysis** of Acoustic and Electrophysiological

**Evidences**), this book by Sven Grawunder is the first fieldwork-based phonetic study, which makes it worth reading.

A book that would interest chemists. physicists, astronomers and engineers is (Spectra of Atoms and Molecules) Bu Peter F. Bernath. It includes a clear presentation of group theory, needed for understanding the material, along with several problems. # GEORGIA 2020: ENERGY POLICY REVIEW

This report by the EU4Energy Programme updates extends the analysis of energy policies in Eastern European countries, the Caucasus Central Asia, that the IEA conducted in 2015. Since the 2015 review, Georgia has made solid progress in improving both the security and sustainability of its energy supply. The country entered into the EU-Georgia Association Agreement in 2016, and has become a Contracting Party of the Energy Community Treaty in 2017. Since then, it has made significant legal and institutional reforms, demonstrating government's commitment to align its energy sector with EU regulations, for electricity and gas markets, security of supply, renewable energy and energy efficiency and statistics. The been energu sector has instrumental in establishing Georgia's overall economic policy, focused on creating a liberalized environment through minimal state interference. deregulation, privatization, reduced and simplified licensing and taxation, and free trade; earning the country the reputation of a "star reformer". Taking advantage of its favorable geographical situation, Georgia plays an important role the regional trade electricity, oil and natural gas.
